The Sophia E. Powell Nursing Scholarship can help.



The WMHS Foundation is pleased to announce that applications are now being accepted for the **Sophia E. Powell Nursing Scholarship**, supporting those pursuing an advanced degree as a Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner (CRNP).

Sophie's nephew, Bob Powell, established the fund in 2022 after witnessing the exemplary care his aunt received at UPMC Western Maryland following a bad fall. During a two-week hospitalization in the Comprehensive Inpatient Rehab Unit, Sophie received compassionate, professional care from nurses, nurse practitioners, physical therapists, occupational therapists, physicians, and pharmacists. As a pharmacist himself, Mr. Powell has worked in hospitals with patients, pharmaceutical research, and the FDA. He met with senior administrators to determine an immediate need here at UPMC and created the Nurse Practitioner scholarship to honor those who helped heal his aunt.

The Sophia E. Powell Nursing Scholarship endowment offers a generous \$20,000 award to the selected applicant, over a two-year period. Scholarship applications must be postmarked or received by 5 pm on June 30, 2023. To be eligible, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Hold a bachelor's degree in nursing (BSN), and be accepted into an accredited CRNP program. Nurses working for UPMC Western Maryland are preferred, but not required.
- * Attend school as a full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours/semester).

Upon graduation, agree to work at UPMC Western Maryland for one year for each year of scholarship received. The selected candidate will be awarded a scholarship of up to \$10,000

(\$20k total) in the fall of 2023 and spring of 2024.

The awardee will be announced by July 14, 2023. For more information, or to apply,
