Application requirements: 8 pages, maximum

1. Complete and sign application and submit by due date, along with the following documents.

- 2. Write and attach a one-page, typed essay describing your educational and professional goals. Explain how this scholarship will affect and benefit your education. State your reasons for pursuing a healthcare career and the contribution you hope to make to patient care and the community you will serve.
- 3. Submit a signed letter of intent to work at UPMC Western Maryland following graduation (downloaded from www.wmhs.com/foundation/major-programs/scholarships/foundation-scholarship-program)
- 4. Attach a copy of your most recent high school or college transcript (a second transcript must be presented by awardees at the end of first semester in order to secure second semester payment).
- 5. Provide proof of acceptance to your school of choice.
- 6. Attach a letter of recommendation from a school/community person (unrelated to you) who can comment on your character and work habits (please provide them with letter of recommendation template).
- 7. Submit a resume, which includes work history, education history, honors and awards, skills, and extra-curricular activities.
